PURPOSE OF APPLICATION:

Under the Freedom Camping Bylaw 2019, Council may use their discretion to grant prior consent for freedom camping. Prior consent may be granted in specific cases, where Council considers the proposed camping is not contrary to the purpose of the bylaw. Prior consent, may be granted with or without conditions, and is at the Council's absolute discretion. A written application must be received at least 10 working days prior to the proposed commencement date.

PRIOR CONSENT APPLICATION FOR FREEDOM CAMPING

Freedom camping must comply with certain requirements

A person camping in accordance with a prior consent granted under clause 4 of the Freedom Camping Bylaw 2019 must –

- Must comply with any conditions included in the consent; and
- Must not commit an infringement offence under the Freedom Camping Act 2011.

Note: Council or a Freedom Camping Enforcement Officer may revoke consented freedom camping where it is believed on reasonable grounds that the person breaches the conditions set out in the Freedom Camping Act 2011, the Freedom Camping Bylaw 2019 or the consent issued.
